Petitioner-Rajinder Kaur @ Genni has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.169 dated 28.07.2017, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is the main accused.

The allegation against the petitioner is that she took ₹2 lakhs from the

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complainant. When the complainant was sent to Dubai, the persons known to the petitioner snatched her passport, suitcase, clothes, purse and ₹20,000/- and thereafter, they employed her for sweeping and cleaning the houses at Dubai and Muskat. The owner of the house where the complainant was employed, asked her for ₹2 lakhs. Thereafter, the complainant desired to return India.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that main allegation is against the present petitioner, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
