The matter was referred to the Civil Judge, Senior Division, Ambala vide order dated 07.07.2017 to adjudicate and to record as to whether the compromise entered into between the parties was arrived at without any threat, coercion or undue influence and that all the legal heirs of the parties have finally settled the matter and that the claim of any third party in the property is not in dispute.

Now the report has been received from the Civil Judge, Senior Division, Ambala, which is placed on the file. As per the report, it has been found that the compromise has been arrived at between the parties with their free will and consent and without any pressure or coercion on either side and the claim of any third party is not not in dispute. It has further been reported that there are no legal heirs to dispute the present compromise.

In view of the above, the CM is allowed and the main appeal is disposed of

in terms of the compromise at Annexure A-2 attached with the CM.

The compromise at Annexure A-2 shall form part of the decree.
