The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.227 dated 17.03.2017 under Section 174-A IPC registered at Police Station Ballabgarh City, District Faridabad (Haryana).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even before registration of the afore-noted FIR, the petitioner had appeared before the trial court and was granted regular bail on 15.03.2017 and therefore, the instant FIR is not maintainable.

This Court by the order dated 05.09.2017, had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balbir Singh, states that in pursuance to the order dated 05.09.2017 the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 05.09.2017, granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute. However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
