[2]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

[3]. In this petition, the petitioners seek directions upon respondent No.2 to protect their life and liberty and that of their other family members from official respondent No.3 and his associated Police Officials. Their grievance is that respondent No.3 has been threatening/intimidating and harassing them on the pretext that while son of petitioner No.1, namely, Ishpreet Singh is wanted in FIR No.195, dated 17.08.2017 registered at Police Station Shimlapuri, District Ludhiana, and his whereabouts are not known, so respondent No.3 has been threatening to arrest/implicate the present petitioners in false criminal cases if the said Ishpreet Singh is not immediately produced.

[4]. Without adverting to the merits of the petitioners' allegations, the present petition is disposed off with a direction upon respondent No.2 to

take notice of the apprehensions expressed by the petitioners and act, accordingly, to ensure that they are not put to any unnecessary harassment/intimidation by respondent No.3.
