The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No. 123 dated 11.08.2015, under Sections 22/21/61.85 of NDPS Act , registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

The prosecution allegations are that the petitioner ran away from the spot on 11.8.2015 and since then remained absconding. Now he has surrendered on 10.08.2017. Learned counsel for the State submits that no other case is pending against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter I think that the petitioner should be given a chance to reform.

Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a statement that after release from the jail the petitioner will file undertaking within two weeks from the date of his release that he would not indulge in any type of offence

and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is ready to give an affidavit as stated above and is not required in any other similar case, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:-

ORDER

- (i) CRM-M-31717-2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
- (iii) The petitioner shall file an affidavit within two weeks from the date of his releasing that he will not commit any other offence again.
