Through this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for quashing F.I.R. No.121 dated 24.09.2016 registered under Sections 420, 380, 496 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Haibowal, District Ludhiana, on the basis of compromise dated 18.04.2017 (Annexure-P2).

Vide order dated 30.08.2017 passed by co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/ Area Magistrate on 26.09.2017 for recording their statements with regard to compromise with a direction to the trial Court/ Area Magistrate to furnish a report qua veracity thereof, if any, between the parties.

Consequently, the parties had appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, on 26.09.2017 and got recorded their statements. Report from the concerned Magistrate has been received vide letter bearing No.1782 dated 06.10.2017 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana vide letter bearing No.1986/EC dated 10.10.2017.

According to the report of Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, the compromise between the parties is genuine, voluntary and without any pressure or coercion in any manner.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, the present petition is accepted and the aforesaid F.I.R. No.121, is quashed qua the petitioners.
