This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by the petitioner seeking direction to the private respondents not to harass the petitioner.

It is contended that husband of petitioner namely Jagtar Singh who was having dispute over agricultural land with his mother and sisters was attacked by respondents No.4 to 8 who were accompanied by some unidentified persons regarding which FIR No.64 dated 08.07.2017 was registered with Police Station Ghanour, District Patiala. Now such private respondents are threatening the petitioner to compromise the matter otherwise she along with her children would be done to death. According to her she has approached S.S.P. Patiala – respondent No.2 to take necessary action in the matter but to no effect. She seeks issuance of direction to

S.S.P. Patiala arrayed as respondent No.2 to ensure the safety of her life and liberty. Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that after filing of the petition, local police has arrested two accused namely Gurmeet Singh and Gursewak Singh arrayed as respondents No.6 and 8 in this case.

Heard.

This petition is disposed of with directions to S.S.P. Patiala – respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner as contained in representation (Annexure P-2) and take all necessary measures to ensure that life and liberty of the petitioner is not jeopardized at the hands of privates respondents or the persons claiming under them and necessary action be taken in the matter, if the circumstances so warrant.
