Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.17 dated 27.02.2015, 419, 420, 467, 468, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and Section 13(2)/7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (for short 'P.C. Act'), registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran, on the basis of compromise.

In the same subject matter, the trial Court, in a suit bearing No.128 of 19.07.2011 that was pending, passed a judgment/decreed dated 30.01.2016 accepting the compromise between the parties, who are the same parties in this court in the present FIR. This Court had directed to record the statement vide order dated 16.09.2016.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Assistant Sub Inspector Gurmukh Singh, states that accordingly, statement has been recorded.

In that view of the matter, by way of compounding and in the wake of the judgment/decreed passed by the civil Court, on 30.07.2016, this petition is allowed. FIR No.17 dated 27.02.2015, 419, 420, 467, 468, 120-B of IPC and Section 13(2)/7 of P.C. Act, registered at Police Station Khem Karan, District Tarn Taran alongwith all consequential proceedings, is quashed by way of compounding/compromise.
