Learned counsel for the petitioner not having been able to produce any document to show that the cancellation of the power of attorney by the principal, i.e. complainant Kulwant Singh, in favour of Jaswinder Singh, is a forged document, and learned counsel appearing for Kulwant Singh (complainant) again reiterating that no compromise has been reached between the parties, it is seen that, as already observed in the order of this Court dated 31.05.2017 passed in the petition earlier filed (CRM-M no.16929 of 2017), the allegation against the petitioner is that he had wrongly identified the vendor in the sale-deed in issue.

Hence, I see no reason to entertain this petition.

Dismissed.

Obviously, nothing stated herein above will be taken as an observation of this Court on the merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, which would be subject matter of investigation, and trial if it comes to that stage.

Very obviously it being a case of an alleged fraud played upon the complainant, if the parties reach a settlement as per law, any other petition filed would be dealt with as per its own merit.
