The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 15.05.2017 registered under Sections 15 & 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

As per the case of the prosecution the petitioner was not named in the FIR. However, she has been named by the co-accused that she is allegedly selling the intoxicant material to the general public.

Learned counsel for the petitioner makes a statement on instructions from the petitioner that the petitioner will file undertaking on affidavit that she would not indulge in any type of offence and would also submit a copy of the affidavit to the concerned Police Station.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is ready to give an affidavit as stated above and the fact that the trial will take its own time

for disposal, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who is a woman.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-31750 OF 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner is directed to join the investigation and fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on *ad-interim* anticipatory bail in FIR No.55 dated 15.05.2017 registered under Sections 15 & 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Bhogpur, District Jalandhar, on furnishing of his bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer, subject to following conditions.
 - (a) The petitioner shall report to the police station concerned on every Monday, Wednesday and Sunday from 11.00am to 4.00pm in addition to appearing before the trial Court on the dates fixed.
 - (b) The petitioner shall give undertaking to the police that she will not indulge in such type of offence in future.
- (iii) In case of violation of the above condition on the part of the petitioner, the liberty is reserved in favour of the State to apply for cancellation of bail.
