On 19.09.2016, following order was passed:-

“Petitioner absented on 09.06.2016 on account of date of hearing i.e. 08.06.2016, having been declared a holiday and the case was adjourned for 08.07.2016. The petitioner did not appear on 09.07.2016 as well.

Notice to the Advocate General, Punjab, for 11.01.2017.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that the petitioner will put in appearance before the trial Court on the date fixed. In case of petitioner doing so, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.”

Perusal of the record reveals that on 26.05.2016, no PW was present and the case was adjourned for unexamined prosecution witnesses on 08.06.2016. 08.06.2016, was

declared as holiday and the case was taken up on 09.06.2016.

On finding the petitioner to be absent, bail was cancelled. Bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State. Non-bailable warrants were issued against the petitioner for 08.07.2016. Non-bailable warrants were not issued by the Ahlmad and he was warned to be careful in future on 08.07.2016.

In view of aforesaid facts, interim protection was granted by this Court vide order dated 19.09.2016. Learned State counsel on instructions from Head Constable Gurmail Singh states that pursuant to the aforesaid order, petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted to interim bail.

In view of aforesaid, order dated 19.10.2016 passed by this Court is made absolute, however, the petitioner shall keep on appearing on each and every date before the trial Court.
