1. Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 54 dated 09.05.2014 registered under Section 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Chabbewal, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since the date of his arrest i.e. 09.05.2017. Final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been submitted to the Court. Nothing has to be recovered from him.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel refuted the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. I have given my anxious consideration to the submissions made by learned counsel for the parties.

5. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances, this Court
