The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier moved a complaint dated 20.9.2013 (Annexure-P-1) before the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, regarding negligence in the medical treatment of her minor daughter by respondent No. 4 doctor. It is stated that on assurance of respondent No. 4 doctor that he will bear the expenses of treatment, she had withdrawn the complaint. Now, respondent No. 4 has backed out from the said undertaking. Therefore, prayer is for reviving of the complaint and conducting fair and impartial inquiry.

The perusal of the petition shows that infact the prayer is to register the FIR and investigate the matter. Let the petitioner approach the learned Illaqa Magistrate with appropriate complaint and prayer.
