Present petition filed by Central Bureau of Investigation, Chandigarh for transfer of trial and other miscellaneous matters pertaining to FIR No.185 dated 05.12.2015 registered under Section 302 read with Section 120-B IPC and Sections 3, 4, & 5 of Explosive Substances Act of Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar from the Court of JMIC, Jalandhar to the learned Court of Special Judicial Magistrate, CBI at Patiala.

Main contention of the petitioner is that the matter is being dealt with Central Bureau of Investigation. At Patiala there is designated Court for dealing with such cases filed by Central Bureau of Investigation. So, this case be also transferred to Special Judge, Patiala.

Having considered the submissions and the facts that right now Central Bureau of Investigation is dealing with the matter and there

is no designated Court of CBI at Jalandhar for dealing with the matters relating to Central Bureau of Investigation. So, present case FIR No.185 dated 05.12.2015 registered under Section 302 read with Section 120-B IPC and Sections 3, 4, & 5 of Explosive Substances Act of Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar stands withdrawn from the of JMIC, Jalandhar and stands transferred to the learned Court of Special Judicial Magistrate, CBI at Patiala for trial in accordance with law.

In view of the above present petition stands disposed of.
