**A. B. CHAUDHARI, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioners have filed these petitions under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.0092 dated 10.06.2016 registered under Sections 324, 148 & 149 IPC and Rapat/Diary No.48 dated 10.06.2016 at Police Station Kot-Kapura, District Faridkot, in view of compromise between the parties.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for private respondents/complainants submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had ordered the trial Court asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly, statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court. Looking to the report it is seen that the compromise is voluntary and genuine. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioners. Looking to the nature of the offence I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

**ORDER**

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-32737 OF 2016 and CRL. MISC. NO. 32737 OF 2016 are allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.0092 dated 10.06.2016 registered under Sections 324, 148 & 149 IPC and Rapat/Diary No.48 dated 10.06.2016 at Police Station Kot-Kapura, District Faridkot, are quashed along with all consequential proceedings, qua the petitioners.
