It is contended that petitioner No.1 – Saniya, aged about 18 years, has married petitioner No.2 Ravi Kumar, aged about 25 years, of her own and her parents i.e. Gurjit – respondent No.4 and mother Assa Rani – respondent No.5, are not happy with the marriage and are threatening to harass and interfere in their married life, as such they have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition, for issuance of appropriate direction.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into the grievance

of the petitioners and to take necessary measures to ensure that lives and liberty of the petitioners are not jeopardized at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 or persons claiming under them.

However, this order shall not validate the marriage between the petitioners and shall not have any effect on any civil or criminal action to which the petitioners may be found liable, under the law.
