ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.238 dated 01.07.2017, under Sections 323, 341, 379, 148 & 149 IPC (Section 308 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioners were empty handed and they had only caught hold of the complainant. He further states that no injuries are attributed to them.

This Court, by the order dated 01.09.2017, had directed the petitioners to join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Parminder Singh, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have joined investigation, the order dated 01.09.2017 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
