The petitioner was arrested on 02.06.2017 in FIR No.673 dated 02.06.2017, under Section 384 IPC and 7, 13(1)(D) of P.C. Act, registered at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat, who has now been dismissed from service.

The allegations against the petitioner is that he used to collect the money for allowing the people to enter in 'no entry' area.

Be that as it may, there is no point to detain him behind bars as under trial, particularly, when he has been dismissed from service.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:-

ORDER

1. Bail petition is allowed.
2. Petitioner be released on bail subject to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
