Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.66 dated 22.07.2017 under Section 420 of IPC (Section 8 of Prevention of Corruption Act added lateron), registered at Police Station Begowal, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the orders dated 14.09.2017 and 15.11.2017 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Daljeet Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the orders dated 14.09.2017 and 15.11.2017 are made absolute.
