The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.42 dated 26.05.2016, under Sections 323/324/148/149 IPC (offence under Section 326 IPC having been added later on), registered at Police Station Kathu Nangal, Amritsar Rural District Amritsar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, the role attributed to the present petitioner is of having inflicted a *datar* blow on the face of Rajwinder Singh. Such injury stands corroborated in terms of medical evidence and has been declared to be grievous in nature thereby attracting offence under Section 326 IPC.

In the light of such serious and direct allegation, this Court is not inclined to extend in favour of the petitioner, concession of pre-arrest bail.

Petition is dismissed.
