ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.51 dated 27.03.2017, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 324, 452 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act (Section 326 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Chhainsa, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that he had inflicted knife blows upon the complainant. He states that the incident occurred due to sudden altercation and the petitioner, who is 20 years of age, is a student of diploma. He is not involved in any other case and he is in custody since the date of his arrest on 22.06.2017.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, states that investigation has been completed and challan has been filed on 17.07.2017. The matter is now listed for

recording the evidence of prosecution evidence, which are 14 in number.

Heard.

The petitioner is 20 years old and a student of diploma. He is not involved in any other case and is in custody for over two and a half months. The investigation has been completed and the conclusion of trial is likely to take some time as 14 prosecution witnesses have been cited. Therefore, I deem it to be a fit case to grant him the concession of regular bail.

Consequently, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
