By filing the present petition, under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner seeks protection of her life and liberty as she has been allegedly receiving threats from respondent Nos. 3 to 6 at the instance of respondent Nos. 7 and 8

Heard.

The learned State counsel, on instructions submits that during the course of investigation, the tower locations/call details of the petitioner and that of respondent No.8 were obtained and the persons from village Nial were joined, whereby it has been revealed that the petitioner had not been residing in village Nial. It has further come on record that the tower location of the mobile phone of the petitioner as

well as of respondent No.8 was not found to be in the area of village Nial. The petitioner has also produced her duly sworn affidavit that she was having friendship with Rachpal Singh, respondent No.8, who had promised to marry her, on his refusal to marry her, she went into depression and in a hasty decision, she got registered the present FIR No.163 dated 19.8.2016, under Sections 376 and 506 of IPC, at Police Station Patran, District Patiala. Through a duly sworn affidavit dated 20.08.2016 (Annexure R1/T) executed, she has further declared that she will have no objection in case the present FIR is cancelled.

In view of the above, the present petition appears to be ill-conceived, therefore, the same warrants dismissal.

Ordered accordingly.
