Petitioner-Prem Singh Saini has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in criminal complaint case No.948 dated 12.10.2012, titled as 'Anwarul Hasan Osmany vs. Balbir Parashar and others', under Sections 406, 418, 423, 424, 420, 465, 468 and 120-B of IPC, pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridabad.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and complainant has also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

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From the record, I find that the petitioner has been summoned in the complaint case.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 30.08.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. Now he has only to face the trial.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that trial of the case will take a long time and no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 30.08.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
