Prayer made in the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of his arrest in Complaint No.582 of 2015 dated 09.07.2015 for offence under Sections 452/323/363/366/499/500/34 IPC and 3(1)(X) of Schedule Caste and Schedule Tribes, Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989 (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 19.09.2016 of this Court, the petitioner was directed to appear/surrender before the learned trial Court and the trial Court was required to admit him to interim bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the certified copy of order dated 21.10.2016, which would reveal that the petitioner has already appeared/surrendered and bail & surety bonds furnished by him, in pursuance of the pointed order of this Court, were attested and accepted by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from investigating officer, has informed that she does not dispute the said fact.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court, the order dated 19.09.2016 passed by this is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall be bound by the conditions imposed by the trial Court
