Petitioner-Jasbir Kaur has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.190 dated 13.07.2017, registered at Police Station Dakha, District Ludhiana, under Sections 420, 406 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that Jasjeet Kumar Babu was the tenant of the present petitioner and a quarrel took place between them and thereafter he vacated the house. He further contended

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that Jasjeet Kumar Babu in connivance with his friend, Tejinder Singh, has filed the present false complaint. He further contended that even as per FIR, ₹50,000/- were given to co-accused Gurinder Singh Gora and thereafter ₹5,50,000/- were paid to Gurinder Singh Gora, Jasvir Kaur (present petitioner) and Raman Rana. He also argued that similarly situated co-accused namely Raman Rana has already been granted the concession of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2017 passed in CRM-M-37081-2017.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 06.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already joined the investigation.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that the petitioner is now not required for custodial interrogation; main accused is Gurinder Singh Gora and co-accused namely Raman Rana, in the similar circumstances, has already been granted the benefit of bail, therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 06.09.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
