Petitioner-Bajinder Kumar @ Binder has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.65 dated 28.06.2017, registered at Police Station City-II, Abohar, District Fazilka, Punjab, under Sections 379, 411, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel has appeared on behalf of respondent-State and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. However, he has been nominated by co-accused. 13 vehicles have been recovered from co-accused Sukhwinder, who stated that he has given 04 stolen Bolero vehicles to the present petitioner for selling the same.

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Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; in view of the allegations against the petitioner and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
