Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in complaint No.10, dated 18.01.2017 filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail for a period of 5 days by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sri Muktsar Sahib, vide order dated 09.08.2017. It is further submitted that the period of 5 days was to expire on Sunday. However, counsel for the petitioner did not get copy of the order. Therefore, time prescribed in conditional order has virtually expired on Friday, since Saturday and Sunday were holidays. Therefore, he could not appear before the trial Court and accordingly, the application filed by the petitioner for seeking extension of time was dismissed vide order dated 19.08.2017. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is ready to appear before the trial Court on 05.09.2017.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to appear before the trial Court on 05.09.2017 and till then, the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
