The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.78 dated 24th March, 2017, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') at Police Station Julana, District Jind on behalf of the petitioner, who is a woman.

It transpires that the petitioner has remained in detention for almost 03 months since her arrest on 12th of June, 2017. After completion of investigation, challan has been submitted against her for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 419, 120-B IPC, all of which are triable by the Magistrate's Court.

In the circumstances, there is no justification to keep the petitioner in detention for an indefinite period. She may, therefore, be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate/Area Magistrate concerned.
