The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No.122 dated 5th July, 2017, registered under Sections 22/29/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Kartarpur, District Jalandhar.

Ld. Counsel for the State submits that the Chemical Analysis Report has since been received and thereafter, challan has been submitted.

Perusal of the relevant report shows that *alprazolam*

was found present in the 50 tablets recovered from the present petitioner. Average weight of each tablet was 130 mg. Consequently, the contraband recovered is certainly a very small quantity. It further transpires that the accused/petitioner is involved in another similar case being FIR No.125 dated 6th July, 2017, although no actual recovery was effected from him in that case.

In the given circumstances, the interim bail granted to the present petitioner, namely Nitin Kumar @ Nanni, earlier, is hereby, confirmed.
