Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing the order dated 19.07.2017 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Malerkotla.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the application (Annexure P-6) filed by respondent-accused, this Court finds that the application dated 19.07.2017 (Annexure P-6) is nothing but a permission to inspect the record and to take the photographs of disputed & standard signatures through Handwriting & Fingerprints Expert. There is no such order by the Magistrate that the respondent-accused has been allowed to examine the witness. Thus, in the absence of a specific application and order thereof, it cannot be accepted that the trial Court has allowed the petitioner to examine the handwriting expert to examine the disputed signatures on cheque.

Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed.
