Through this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to petitioner Liyakat Ali in case F.I.R. No.143 dated 15.05.2015 under Sections 22, 61, 85 of the N.D.P.S. Act, registered at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana, during pendency of the trial.

The petitioner was apprehended with 100 grams of intoxicants.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 22.05.2017. Earlier the petitioner had jumped the bail because of his illness and he himself surrendered before the Court after one year when he recovered from his illness.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail during trial, subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
