Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to hand over the investigation of FIR No.92 dated 07.08.2017 under Sections 302, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Barnala, District Barnala, to Central Bureau of Investigation or any other independent agency or to any senior officer of the police of any other district for fair and impartial inquiry.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and noticing the fact that the FIR was registered on 07.08.2017, this Court finds that the matter is under investigation with the police. Therefore, no such interference is warranted at this stage. However, the prayer of the counsel for the petitioner that respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, may be directed to look into

representation dated 08.08.2017 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner, can be accepted to the extent that respondent No.4 should look into the contents of said representation and to act in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without making any comment on the claim as projected in representation dated 08.08.2017 (Annexure P-5), present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala, to look into the contents of representation dated 08.08.2017 (Annexure P-5) and to act in accordance with law.
