The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.74 dated 24.04.2015 for the offence under Sections 376, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.4, Ludhiana.

Petitioner is in custody since 25.04.2015.

A perusal of the order dated 10.08.2016 passed by this Court shows that regular bail has been granted to Krishan Parshad who is main accused. The similar role was attributed to him. The affidavits have been filed by parents of the prosecutrix i.e.Vishav Nath Gupta and Urmila Devi (Annexure P-4 Colly.) and prosecutrix (Annexure P-5) wherein, it has been stated that FIR had been registered on account of some misunderstanding and dispute with the petitioner with regard to transaction of Rs.1 Lac, which has now been settled.

Keeping in view the above and considering the fact that trial is likely to take time for its own conclusion, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaqa Magistrate, Ludhiana.
