Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.58 dated 21.05.2017 under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Kabarwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Malkit Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated September 01, 2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
