Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.192 dated 09.08.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 326 and 307 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Mullana, District Ambala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dev Chand, states that in the present case, co-accused Sanju has been arrested, who has disclosed that the petitioner had accompanied him in the commission of the offence.

In view of the above, this Court finds that the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail in this case.

Accordingly, the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.

The observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
