The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 112 dated 27.07.2017 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

On 01.09.2017 this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is the mother-in-law of the complainant and there is no specific allegation of entrustment of dowry articles against her.

Notice of motion for 10.10.2017.

The petitioner is directed to join the investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the

Arresting Officer, she shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That she shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
2. That she shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
3. That she shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of above, the order dated 01.09.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to furnishing of bail-bonds/surety bonds by the petitioner to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
