Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Emanul Mal , Police Station Dorangla, District Gurdaspur states that the petitioners have since joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from them. She further states that the allegations regarding the petitioners having been caused injuries to complainant on 22.08.2017 have not been found to be true, she states that the petitioners are not required further for investigation by the police.
