Petitioner-Gurdev Singh has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. SHO, Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar, to submit police report/cancellation report prepared by the police in FIR No.15 dated 25.01.1994, under Sections 324, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that though the FIR in question was registered on 25.01.1994 and the petitioner was made to aware that the aforesaid FIR has been cancelled, but the cancellation report was not submitted. On account of non-submission of cancellation report to the court, the petitioner is facing hardship in getting the passport. He states that as on date, no FIR is pending

against him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Govinder Singh, states that by mistake the police record could not be updated and the factum of cancellation was not recorded in the police record. However, now the police has rectified the mistake and as on date, there is no FIR against the petitioner.

In view of the fact that the police has updated their record and as on date, FIR No.15 dated 25.01.1994, under Sections 324, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar, is not pending against the petitioner as the same has been cancelled, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.
