ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.165 dated 16.04.2017 under Sections 307/34/364 IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Sonapat (later on challan presented under Sections 324/326/364/34 IPC).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per allegations in the FIR, both the injuries attributed to the petitioner are on non-vital parts of the body of the injured, as one injury is on the right shoulder and other injury on the right thigh. He further contends that injury no.1 which has been caused with knife, appears to be simple in nature but in the medico-legal report, it was opined as grievous. It has not been specified by the doctor as to how the injury is grievous as there was no fracture. He further contends that the injured was

discharged from the hospital after four days and has completely recovered. He further states that the petitioner is in custody for almost four months ever since his arrest on 12.05.2017

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, states that investigation has been completed and even charges have been framed in this case on 06.09.2017.

Heard.

The injuries attributed to the petitioner are on non-vital parts of the body of injured. The petitioner is in custody for over three and a half months. The investigation has been completed.

In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. Petitioner Manjeet Lakra is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
