This petition has been filed for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner – Paramjit Singh, an accused in FIR No.37 dated 6.7.2017, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 341, 506, 326 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Banga.

As per the prosecution case, the incident had took place on 4.7.2017 in the area of village Poonia, Police Station Banga in which the Amarjit Singh had been attacked by Lakhi and Happy armed with iron *datars* causing multiple injuries to him and one Tajinder Singh.

The role attributed to the petitioner is that he had brought the complainant to the place of incident on the pretext of resolving the dispute

between him and the accused side. No injury is attributed to the present petitioner. He is stated to be aged about 40 years. He was arrested in this case on 26.7.2017. The trial is going on and its conclusion is likely to take considerable time.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find it proper and appropriate, if concession of regular bail is granted to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail during the pendency of the trial, subject to his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar, subject to the following conditions:

- (i) He shall appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing.
- (ii) He shall not give any threat or intimidation to the prosecution witnesses.
- (iii) He shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

However, to address the apprehensions expressed by learned State counsel that petitioner may not abscond or tamper with the prosecution evidence, it is directed that the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar would make the petitioner surrender his passport, if it has not got done by the investigating agency earlier.

In addition to that the trial Court may impose any term and

condition found suitable.

In case the petitioner violates any term and condition on which the bail has been granted to him, the prosecution would be entitled to apply for cancellation of bail.
