Petitioner-Naresh Kumar has filed this petition under Section 438 read with Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in criminal complaint No.652 dated 19.11.2012, under Sections 452, 506, 420, 467 and 471 read with Section 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, Police Station Sadar, Hisar.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

However, none has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 despite service.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as

learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

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From the record, I find that the petitioner has been summoned in a complaint case.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 02.02.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been released on interim bail. He has only to face the trial which may take a long time. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes. Therefore, no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I find merit in the present petition and the same is allowed. The order dated 02.02.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
