Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the instigation of respondents No.4 to 6 who are the mother and other relatives of petitioner No.2.

Notice of motion.

Mr. K.S. Sidhu, D.A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3- State and Mr. Sandeep Kumar, Advocate has appeared on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for respondents No.4 to 6 submits that respondents may be permitted to talk to petitioner No.2 to know about her well being and whether if she was under any pressure. The parties were permitted to talk to each other and the matter is again taken up now.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners are major and have performed marriage on their own will and without any pressure.

He further submits that the respondents have verified the fact that petitioner No.2 is not ready to accompany them and wants to stay with petitioner No.1 with whom she has allegedly married.

In view of the same, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioners in pursuance to the representation dated 31.08.2017 (Annexure P-5).

The observations made above do not acknowledge legal or valid marriage between the petitioners.
