Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.60 dated 4.8.2017 under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the instant FIR was registered at the behest of complainant-Gurjit Singh, who is real son of petitioner no.1–Mohinder Kaur, however, during investigation, the complainant himself has been found to be an accused. He further submits that petitioner no.1 is a poor and rustic old lady and she has acted as per the

instructions of her son. As far as petitioner no.2 - Charan Singh is concerned, the only allegation against him is that he has identified petitioner No.1 - Mohinder Kaur, who has impersonated as Amar Kaur.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner no.1 in Court, as per which, he is in custody for about one month and there is no other case pending against him.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the offences against the petitioners are triable by a Magistrate and conclusion of trial may take long time, I deem it appropriate to release them on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioners are admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of their bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.

However, the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as any expression on the merits of the case.
