Petitioner is seeking direction to respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to register a criminal case against respondent Nos. 6 to 8 and conduct impartial investigation in the matter.

On 20.09.2016, a direction was given to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to call the petitioner, record her statement and thereafter, inform the Court with regard to the CD, if any. Thereafter, on 18.10.2016, learned counsel for respondent No.6 had informed the Court that family members of the petitioner and respondent No.6 had agreed to solemnize their marriage.

Today, Manisha-petitioner and Raju Singh-respondent No.6 have appeared in Court. Manisha has been identified by ASI Sukhminder Singh.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that in compliance with the order dated 20.09.2016 passed by this Court, statement

of Manisha has been recorded and the CD in question has been recovered.

The Investigating Officer is directed to destroy the CD today itself.

Keeping in view that the petitioner and respondent No.6 have solemnized marriage, no directions are required to be given in this petition.
