SURINDER GUPTA, J.(Oral)

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 176 dated 10.08.2016 registered for offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 325, 452, 148, 506 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code (for short, "IPC") at Police Station Shimlapuri, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Heard.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner has been attributed injury caused by *dat* which hit near ear of Surinder Pal Singh. That injury was not declared dangerous to life.

The petitioner was arrested on 12.08.2016 and is in custody since then. Charges have also been framed against him.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sandeep @ Kaka is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the

satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.
