Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.58 dated 18.06.2016 under Sections 323, 324, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Islamabad, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 05.09.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurcharan Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 05.09.2017 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
