ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.179 dated 06.07.2010 under Section 36(1) of The Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act, 1995 registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District Mohali.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he had been earlier granted anticipatory bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Mohali on 11.08.2011, but later on his bail petition was dismissed on 11.08.2017 as he had been declared proclaimed offender. He further contends that the FIR was registered in the year 2010 and no action had been taken subsequently and therefore, he was under the impression that he is not required in the case.

Learned counsel states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition, as he shall be surrendering before the trial Court and applying for regular bail which may be decided by the trial Court expeditiously.

The instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court and apply for regular bail, which may be decided in accordance with law expeditiously.
