Petitioner-Kulwant Kaur has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.156 dated 19.07.2017, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda, under Sections 384, 342, 323 and 506 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation whereas learned State counsel submitted that the petitioner has not joined the investigation.

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At the time of arguments, learned State counsel argued that in this case, cancellation report has already been prepared and the same is pending before SSP concerned for final approval.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that the prosecution has already prepared cancellation report, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in this petition, the same is allowed. The order dated 04.09.2017, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the condition that she shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
