This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by petitioner Mukesh Kumar craving for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to trace out his wife Laxmi and minor child, namely, Vidhi, stated to be in illegal custody of private respondents No. 4 to 7.

Admittedly, petitioner has not lodged any FIR in the matter. In that case, the police during the course of investigation would have made earnest efforts to recover the alleged detenues. He had another remedy of filing a writ for habeas corpus or approaching the area

Magistrate, under Sections 98 and 99 Cr.P.C., which remedy he has not availed of till date.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he be allowed to withdraw the petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn relegating the petitioner to the remedies as aforesaid, if so advised.
