INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Gurvinder Singh has filed this petition under 482 Cr.P.C. against respondents-State of Haryana and others for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect his life and liberty and also not to harass and humiliate him at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and gone through the record, especially the representation dated 28.08.2017 (Annexure P-1), sent by the petitioner to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar.

Perusal of the record shows that respondent No.4-Amarjeet Kaur is wife of the present petitioner and as per the allegations in the representation, the petitioner has stated that after marriage, he came to know that his wife is a lady of rich fond, however, he is a small farmer. He has

also stated that his wife is a quarrelsome lady and always used to mess with him to get transferred his agricultural land in her name and also used filthy language. It is also mentioned in the representation that she never appreciated him, rather taunts him for being poor. It is also mentioned in the representation that about 20 days back, she left the matrimonial home after quarreling with him on petty matter. It is also mentioned in the representation that his wife openly threatened him that she will implicate him and his family members in false cases.

Perusal of the representation, itself, shows that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, rather whatever stated in the representation by the petitioner is wear and tear of the matrimonial life. No ground is made out for providing protection to the petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
